## **Gallery Walk**

The Gallery Walk is an interactive discussion technique that allows students to focus on other students' mathematical thinking and solutions.

## Procedure:

- 1. Have students work in groups to solve a mathematical problem and to record their thinking on chart paper.
- 2. Post the chart paper solutions around the classroom. Direct students to stand at their own solution and then rotate the groups clockwise to a new solution.
- 3. Ask students to read and analyze the solution on the chart paper and then record comments, questions, and/or suggestions for improvement using sticky notes or by writing directly on the chart paper.
- 4. After three to five minutes, have groups rotate to the next solution. Remind students to read what has already been written and to add only new comments, questions, and/or suggestions.
- 5. Continue the rotations until groups have been to at least three solutions.
- 6. Instruct groups to return to their own solution and to read the comments, questions, and/or suggestions. Students can use the feedback to make changes to their solution.
