Oral Language Activities

Mini-Congress

A Mini-Congress strategy enables students to share their solutions with another group, prior to participation in a Math Congress.

Procedure:

- 1. Ask students to meet with another group to share and defend their solutions to a problem. Students should check answers and strategies and ask questions to provoke clarification and/or elaboration of ideas and thinking.
- 2. Circulate from group to group to determine the types of strategies students are using and their ability to communicate with others to describe their thinking.
