Mix-Pair-Share

Mix-Pair-Share is a variation of Think-Pair-Share which enables a random selection of partners and sharing of alternate perspectives.

Procedure:

- 1. Have students silently mix around the room (no talking).
- 2. Call "pairs" and instruct students to pair up with the person closest to them.
- 3. Tell students who have not found a partner to raise their hands so that they can find each other.
- 4. Pose a question or prompt.
- 5. Give students time to think about the prompt.
- 6. Provide time for partners to discuss their ideas.
- 7. Then have each pair share their ideas with the whole group.
