## **Walkabout**

The Walkabout strategy provides students with the opportunity to compare their thoughts and ideas with others and to add new ideas to their own thinking.

## Procedure:

1. Choose a topic or pose a question.

- 2. Create small groups of students, or have students work individually.
- 3. Have each group (or student) record their ideas about the topic or question.

  Note: Individual students can then circulate around the room and form
- 4. Have one student from each group join another group and share the home group's ideas.
- 5. Then have students return and report any new ideas to their original group members.
- 6. The group then decides whether or not they can use the new information to support their thinking.
